

**Town of Anderson
Annual Town Meeting
April 16th, 2013
Located at the Town Hall**

Called to order: The meeting was called to order at 7:14 p.m. by Tim Harmon. Public count: 3.

Approval of last year's minutes: The minutes will be approved at next year's annual town meeting due to the clerk not bringing them to the meeting.

Annual financial report: The annual financial report was presented by the Clerk Jessica King. Jim Ulmaniec made a motion to accept the financial report, seconded by Randy Schadow. Motion carried 3-0.

Set date for 2014 annual town meeting: The date for next year's meeting will be held per state statute on the third Tuesday of April. The date will be April 15, 2014.

Gopher bounty: Motion made to leave gopher bounty same as set last year by Randy Schadow, seconded by Tim Harmon. Motion carried 3-0.

Posting sites: Motion made to advise the town board to pursue approval from the two churches contained in the town to allow us to put up posting signs on their locations leaving the posting site at County Road O with the new posting sign by Randy Schadow, seconded by Jim Ulmaniec. Motion carried 3-0.

Land sale easement of Pete Manship property: Jim Ulmaniec made a motion to advise the board to grant an easement or driveway to Pete Manship and cut to the allowed easement and leaving no buffer strip, seconded by Randy Schadow. Motion carried 3-0.

Dog license donation: Motion made to continue donating the dog fund surplus money to the Humane Society by Jim Ulmaniec, seconded by Randy Schadow. Motion carried 3-0.

Snow plowing: Motion for the board to revisit the driveway snow plowing issue by their June meeting by Jim Ulmaniec, seconded by Randy Schadow. Motion carried 3-0.

Culvert issue on Oeltjen road: Motion that the board address the culvert issue on Oeltjen road just east of Sterling having the board address it as soon as possible by Tim Harmon, seconded by Jim Ulmaniec. Motion carried 3-0.

Adjourn: Motion to adjourn by Jim Ulmaniec, seconded by Randy Schadow. Motion carried 3-0 and the meeting adjourned at 7:50 p.m.
