BOARD MEETING
Scott Town Hall
May 22, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 1:00 p.m. by Chairman Mick Peterson. All members and Clerk Karen Wiggins were present. John Marzitelli, owner of the property on the SE corner of A&H, and James Flanigan, Burnett County Zoning Administrator, were present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited and meeting notice postings verified.

DISCUSSION AND ACTION:

Liquor License: The board informed Mr. Marzitelli that the town had a Class "B" and a "Class B" liquor license available.

Land Parcel: Those present reviewed documents, including surveys, presented by both Mr. Marzitelli and Mr. Flanigan. A small parcel between Mr. Marzitelli's property and the Town's property, identified in a survey, was in dispute as to ownership. Everyone then left the hall and viewed the parcels. It was the conclusion of everyone present that, due to the survey of the parcel in question never having been recorded with the county, the Town of Scott still retains ownership of the parcel.

The board agreed to run the town's northernmost property line at a slight angle heading southeast to ensure that Mr. Marzitelli will retain use of his property as it is now configured. Mr. Marzitelli will have his property surveyed, at his expense, and present the survey to the board for their approval before filing the survey with the county.

The Chair will have the Road Supervisor estimate the cost to Mr. Marzitelli to have the soil bank reinforced to prevent the bank from washing out.

Long Lake Road Paving Contract: *Motion by Kathy Young, seconded, to accept Monarch's contract at a cost of \$107,016.86, with the town providing part of the work by the town's road crew.*

The meeting was adjourned at 2:12 p.m.
